

Rules and Regulations Policy

When visiting the Winton Cemetery District, it is important to follow the following rules to keep visiting the cemetery harmonious, peaceful, and respectful. Loud and abusive conduct is not permitted. By following the rules and etiquette established by the district, it helps maintain a peaceful surrounding for everyone.

- No private parties, picnicking, barbecuing, open flames, or leaving food and drinks at gravesites.
- No tables, tents, tarps, or pop-up shades.
- No planting sod, grass, plants, or shrubbery on cemetery grounds.
- No running, playing, or games of any kind are allowed.
- No alcohol, drugs, smoking, vaping, weapons, or fireworks allowed on cemetery grounds.
- No musical groups or playing loud music.
- No parking on grass area or on gravesites. Please Park on the edge of the roadway.
- No leaning, sitting, or climbing on headstone.
- No leaving clothing, hats, or bandanas on the gravesites.
- No animals allowed on Cemetery grounds with the exception of leashed guide or service dogs.
- Winton Cemetery District has the authority to remove anything that does not conform with District policies.
- Please be respectful of others visiting their loved ones.
- Cemetery visitors must comply with cemetery staff and local law enforcement.
- Loitering, sleeping, or sun-bathing is not permitted.
- Irrigating and fountain water is not for human consumption, bathing, or washing.
- Please keep an eye on your children at all times.
